The AFN is inviting dynamic speakers to submit a proposal to participate as a keynote speaker, panelist, or presenter. Suggested topic areas include, but are not limited to:

- Mental wellness and self-care for frontline workers
- Land- and culture-based approaches in supporting children and families

- Projected length of presentation (not including questions and answer period)
- Speaker title(s) and contact information
- Key take aways and benefits for participants at the JPSCG
