National First Nations Homelessness Action Plan Dialogue Session and Technical Update

SESSION DESCRIPTION:

As mandated by First Nations-in-Assembly through Resolution 79/2019, *Action Plan for First Nations Homelessness On and Off Reserve*, the Assembly of First Nations (AFN) is pleased to present the completed draft National First Nations Homelessness Action Plan (Action Plan) to address First Nations homelessness. The Action Plan sets out recommendations for all levels of government, supports regional strategies and approaches, and sets out tangible actions for the AFN and First Nations to take forward in their ongoing advocacy work.

The session will focus on an overview of the entire action plan and discuss the path forward. Implementing the Action Plan will require ongoing efforts led by First Nations with the support of government and other partners to drastically reduce or eliminate First Nations homelessness.

Background:

In November 2020, a Joint Technical Working Group was established between AFN, including Regional Technicians and Employment and Social Development Canada's technical staff to guide the co-development of the Action Plan. The Action Plan is a result of four years of working in consultation and cooperation with government and First Nations.
