# The 2<sup>nd</sup> AFN Indigenous Laws Gathering

June 11-12, 2024 | Hotel Musée Premières Nations, Wendake, Quebec

The Assembly of First Nations (AFN) is hosting the second AFN Indigenous Laws Gathering which will take place on June 11-12, 2024, at the Hôtel-Musée Premières Nations in Wendake, Quebec, located on the ancestral lands of the Huron-Wendat Peoples.

The theme of this year's Gathering is *Holding Space: Elevating Indigenous Laws to Address Historical Wrongs*, with a focus on the establishment of an independent centre for the resolution of specific claims.

This Gathering will bring together the AFN Council of Experts on Indigenous Laws (CEIL), members of the AFN Councils, AFN Chiefs Committee on Lands, Territories and Resources, and other guests to engage in facilitated discussion, learn from First Nations Knowledge Keepers and thought

leaders, and contribute to ongoing efforts to co-develop a specific claims process that creates equal space for First Nations laws and legal orders.

We welcome First Nations participation in this important work.
