The Assembly of First Nations (AFN) will be hosting its Special Chiefs Assembly (SCA) from December 1-4, 2025, at the Rogers Centre located at 55 Colonel By Drive, Ottawa, ON, K1N 9J2.

ABOUT US

The AFN is a national advocacy organization that works to advance the collective aspirations of First Nations across Canada on matters of national or international nature. The AFN hosts two assemblies a year where mandates and directives for the organization are established through resolutions directed and supported by the First Nations-in-Assembly (elected Chiefs or proxies from member First Nations).

In addition to the direction provided by Chiefs of each member First Nation, the AFN is guided by an Executive Committee consisting of an elected National Chief and Regional Chiefs from each province and territory. Representatives from five national councils (Knowledge Keepers, Youth, Veterans, 2SLGBTQQIA+, and Women) support and guide the decisions of the Executive Committee.

The SCA will be an opportunity for Chiefs to come together to consider issues of concern to First Nations governments and citizens, and to mandate the AFN to undertake work to advance the rights and interests of First Nations.
