## Additions to Reserve Redesign: Advancing First Nations Priorities

### Session Description:

In 2021, the Government of Canada committed to work with First Nations to redesign the Additions to Reserve (ATR) policy and process, resulting in a three-year budget commitment, and a national engagement process with First Nations led by Crown Indigenous Relations and Northern Affairs (CIRNA), in 2023.

AFN's mandates direct it to engage with First Nations on ATR reform and identify recommendations that meet the diverse needs of First Nations. To advance its mandate, the AFN carried out several initiatives in 2023 resulting in a critical analysis outlined in a series of ATR Policy Reform 'One Pagers' that require First Nations feedback and validation.

This 2024 AFN Dialogue Session will provide First Nations leadership and technicians a focused opportunity to engage with AFN's analysis and support the development of concrete recommendations to redesign the ATR policy and process.

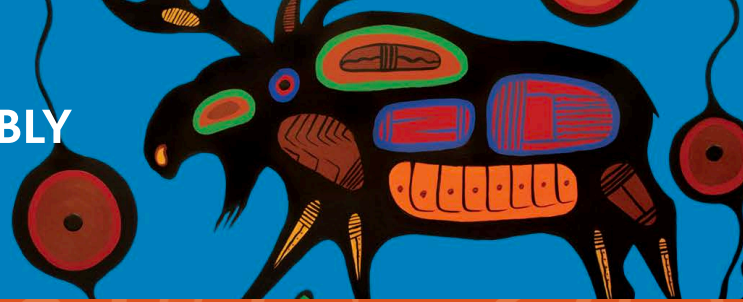
