DIALOGUE SESSION

First Nations Early Learning and Child Care Funding Allocation Model Dialogue Session and Technical Update

Monday, December 4, 2023, at 1:00 p.m. – 2:00 p.m. EST Room 208, Shaw Centre

SESSION DESCRIPTION:

The dialogue session will provide an update on the AFN's work to develop a funding allocation model for the federal budget for First Nations Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC) until 2027-28. This dialogue session will include an opportunity for participants to discuss the future of First Nations ELCC, including priorities for First Nations ELCC funding. The dialogue session will also provide a technical briefing on the Institute of Fiscal Studies and Democracy's (IFSD) research on First Nations ELCC funding allocation models and an overview of future work needed in this field.

Background:

In 2018, the Government of Canada invested \$1.02 billion over ten years in First Nations Early Learning and Child Care (ELCC) to support strategic investments in First Nations-identified priorities for ELCC programs, services, governance and more. In the 2020 Fall Economic Statement and Budget 2021, the Government of Canada invested \$878.53 million over five years in First Nations ELCC programs and services, major capital, repairs and renovations, and capacity building. These funds are subject to the direction of First Nations leadership by way of a resolution to allocate funds to each region. The First Nations-in-Assembly have called for the development of a First Nations ELCC funding allocation model through Assembly of First Nations (AFN) Resolutions 59/2018, 64/2019, 20/2020, and most recently 05/2021, Allocation of Early Learning and Child Care Investments in Budget 2021
